Rapid Response services are used to assist affected workers with: finding new employment in the same career; receiving occupational training for a new career, or assisting workers during their job search.

The Partnership works with employers to coordinate layoff events and to inform affected workers of their rights and responsibilities, as well as the resources available to them to facilitate a smooth transition during a layoff.
